first review. Weekly raffles will be held for all readers sharing for each particular week. All participants will be invited to a final summer celebration on Monday, August 13 at 6:30 PM.

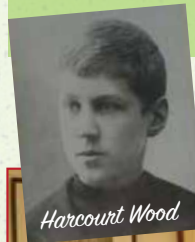


3D Doodle Pens at Teen Maker Space

Mr. and Mrs. Hamilton "Tony" Holton Wood, Jr. Colonel Hamilton Holton Wood is Tony's great grandfather. He did not name a son after himself so the name skipped a generation until Orrin G. Wood, the Colonel's son, who had 6 children; 2 daughters followed by 4 sons. One of which was named Hamilton Holton Wood. One son was named Orrin G. Wood, Jr. was Tony's great uncle and was present

at the Library's rededication. Orrin Jr. taught Tony how to sail among other things. Tony and Annie donated a photograph of Orrin G. Wood aged 12 years old, the Library's honorary Trustee and brother to Holton Harcourt Wood.
